

PRESIDENTS REPORT

To the Annual General Meeting of the Maritzburg College Old Boys' Association (MCOBA) being held at 17:30 on Tuesday the 10th of May 2022

It is my pleasure to submit my annual report of the President to the Old Boys and all College Stakeholders at this year's Annual General Meetings as required by clause 17.6 (a) of the MCOBA constitution.

At the outset I confirm, per clause 10.2, that my term of office of one year is up and per clause 10.2, where a President is encouraged to complete a second year of office, I make myself available for a second year of office, if this AGM so decides, when we address the election of newly proposed Executive Committee members per clause 17.6 (d) of the MCOBA Constitution.

Executive Summary

I am pleased to report that MCOBA is in a very healthy state. We have been served and continue to be served, by Old Boys who give of their time endlessly and who immerse themselves and their energy into serving College Old Boys and our school, College.

The MCOBA:

- is financially sound, as noted by the Annual Financial Statements tabled today and the clean Audit Report.
- Continues to focus on its Objectives as set out in paragraph 5 of our Constitution.
- Is actively increasing its relevance to Old Boys as will be noted in this report.
- Has been focused on its core strategy for 2022, that is "having more events" and "bringing back the fun".

There are no proposed amendments tabled to the constitution.

No submissions for Honorary Life Members have been received and so none are tabled for consideration.

There is no special business to note for the agenda.

No changes to the Honorary Auditor being Andre de Valence (CA) SA of GC Ford Inc.

Operationally, detailed Service Level Agreements with College Business are agreed and are being delivered on with agreed Key Performance Indicators being monitored.

The 22nd of January 2022 marked the momentous occasion of the Maritzburg College Old Boys' Association's 125th Birthday, celebrated with a first ever global event for Old Boys, being a globally coordinated celebration that included:

- 72 registered gatherings
- On 5 continents
- In 12 countries
- Across 10 time zones
- 32 locations in South Africa alone

It was a significant occasion as globally, Old Collegians along with family and friends, **paused**, took stock of our forefathers and their actions that have led us to "**a 125 yrs later**". We shared meals: breakfasts, lunches and suppers; with hundreds, of Old Boys and the wider College Community across the globe and gave thanks and acknowledge this momentous occasion in our history.

Reunion 2022

After 3 long years, at long last and mindful and in no way attempting to down play the very harsh reality that has impacted all our families, friends and the wider College Community; often littered with personal tragic outcomes due to COVID-19 that includes the mental aspects humanity has endured, we have a College Old Boys reunion just weeks away!

To say your Executive have prepared for this would be an understatement, we have been preparing for 3 years! Hours and hours of effort have been invested into Reunion.

Further to this, many other events have taken place and are planned to take place and they are listed below so that the extent of the effort of the Old Boys office and Exec can be clearly noted.

This aligns into our MCOBA Strategy which was refined, in an all-day strategy session held at the Kent Pavilion on the 15th October 2021.

I must add, it has been a personal goal of mine to ensure we engage with our veteran old Boys and I am very pleased to report below that a number of events have taken place to accommodate this that includes a breakfast in Howick followed, at the invitation of the

Technology

Significant changes have been implemented into our operations at College Old Boys that have digitally enabled us to meet our Old Boys spread out across the globe. These include the roll out and go live of:

- College Connect Community using US technology owned by a US firm, Graduway, that services the US Ivy League universities.
 - College Connect brings our community together by digitally enabling new features that the old technology, Alumnet, did not and includes: a jobs board, Business to Business opportunities and a mentorship program.
 - Most notably it is user friendly and links to Facebook and LinkedIn, tools our communities already use.
 - Significantly, 7 Corporate Partners have provided the \$5000 needed for the first year of annual fees of the initial 5-year contract with Graduway. MCOBA, has also contributed +- \$2500 from funds held in the Old Boys UK Bank Account.
 - Note: the decommissioning of Alumnet has been planned for May 2022 and will save Old Boys R1880 a month.
- Completely new website that integrates to the: School, College Foundation, College Connect and College Shoppe.
- New payment gateway with our very own merchant account enabling payment for: subs, events and anything else on a global scale with ease.
- Office iPhone loaded with entire MCOBA database.



- Creation of office "persona" RD Clark complete with email address, Whatsapp profile and Facebook account.
- WhatsApp Groups newly launched to meet the preferred communication methods of old boys and particularly those abroad.
- Trello, a project management tool, is now in its second year and is housing detailed operational information that is critical to running the Old Boys Office.
- Voting forms (Formbuilder123), ensuring decisions are informed and voted on.
- Online Debit Order Mandate forms including secure online Cloud storage.
- MCOBA domain including secure online cloud storage.
- MCOBA Zoom account to facilitate communications globally.

Office Bearers

A number of long-term serving members of the Executive are opting to stand down and I would like to thank:

- Gary Banfield who has served 10 years, in the office as "Honorary Treasurer" and then
 to lead our Strategy portfolio. I have enjoyed wise council from Gary but I know
 Executives before will recognise his significant contributions to Old Boys through many
 more years than I can speak for.
- Grant Sayers who has given 4 years of significant effort ensuring we have had timely
 management accounts and then annual financial statements. He has attended to
 many finance related questions and has also assisted with the reporting on our
 investment. I know he has invested personal time over weekends to ensure our
 accounting remained in tip top shape.
- Bruce Lesur who has served this Old Boys executive through so many years in all positions in including that of President and continues to give of his time unstintingly, is stepping down as Vice-President, a position you will notice remains unfilled and will need to be filled through the course of the year. Bruce kindly agreed to return and assist me as my Vice President in my first year of office as President particularly as it was our 125th Year. I have enjoyed incredible wisdom and engagement from Bruce over this past year for which I am eternally grateful for. I am pleased to say Bruce will continue to service Old Boys through his main passion, which is Rugby, via the Weaner Rugby Project.
- Ant Williamson who has served 2 years, in the office as "Head of Projects" has almost single handedly turned an annual golf day into something that could almost rival a Golf



Major. It sells out in a matter of hours now and I know when he took this task on, we struggled to fill the field. The energy and attention to detail and generosity of his time has been immense. His role across Reunion and Project has also been immense and the energy he injects into "geeing" up the troops is beyond measure. He assures me he will be backing and supporting his incumbent, Devon and for this we are very grateful.

- Patrick O'Connell who has served 2 years, helping run the portfolio of Membership and Participation has shared generously of his wisdom gained through his years involved with College. A passionate Exec member matched perhaps only by Ant Williamson and I know his support will never fail us.
- Robin Westley who has served 2 years, in the office helping run the portfolio of Membership and Participation and who also held the office of Vice-President has had to navigate some very tricky time-consuming years at College which included his position as Chairman of the College Foundation. Robin has given unreservedly and invested hours and hours of his time for the benefit of College. He has always been a very calm and level headed voice of reason in our Executive and he knows I personally had hoped he would have reconsidered the position of Vice-President again.

We will in time be running an event to thank these servants of College but I would like to formally thank them all and the truth is, that nothing I could say could do it justice enough but, Thank You Gentlemen!

With all these changes, there might be cause for alarm? I assure you passionate Old Boys are not short in abundance; the challenge is to ensure they have "time to give" and I believe those being nominated tonight for office have fresh ideas and passion to breath into Old Boys and indeed some younger years are filtering in which is exciting as Old Boys needs to remain relevant to all.

Financial Affairs

Old Boys are in a sound financial position.

A far more detailed budget is being tracked to this year to keep us focused on achieving our targets so that this strong position is not jeopardized.

Further to this, the monthly management accounts have been enhanced to report on management information that allows the executive to make decisions based on the financial information.



A project is underway to introduce new digitized systems with document storage of all invoices and an enhanced approval processes as well as automated banking feeds into a new general ledger called Zero.

This will all be further enhanced with straight through processing into a management reporting tool called "Spotlight" that will reduce the effort and time required in producing management accounts.

Critical to Finances is our income and so I include a detailed report on this and post reunion we will start to request OC, that are not paid up, to consider being paid up members. Note, this is a change in strategy this year. In prior years a letter was sent early in the year to request such payment of subs. The Executive have taken a strategy to deliver on service and a reunion before sending out such requests. That said, anyone who has paid for reunion on our new payment portal, will have been asked to consider adding subs to their bill.

The executive has been very mindful that there is a need to demonstrate service to all old boys to justify the request for subs and we believe we are doing just this.

Maritzburg College Old Boys Memorial Trust

Mr. Sven Jager, Chairman of the Maritzburg College Old Boys Memorial Trust has provided a report on the financial affairs of the Memorial Trust which is tabled to this AGM and it talks to the healthy state of affairs of the Memorial Trust.

Operations

The central service team, **College Business**, has taken a few years to mature into the well-oiled machine it is now. The foresight to move to this new operating model and effort to get it operational, that MCOBA had navigated through was not an easy journey of change but it has been worth it and College Business is a game changer whereby dedicated permanent resource execute on the needs of MCOBA that ensures a level of service that is not based on a" best efforts" basis.

We welcome Sam Paterson who joined the team in March 2022 and she splits her time equally between Old Boys and the school. She services College as their **Events Manager** and for Old Boys heads up our **Communications** portfolio which includes: Newsletters and Social Media. We are expecting big things from Sam through 2022/2023 – Welcome Sam.

If our engine room of Old Boys, being **College Business**, could be likened to rugby, well then:

Sue Buchanan-Clarke would be an **entire scrum**! The work effort she has put out in the past 6 months with efficiency and output into Operations, just simply kicked Old Boys and our capabilities into the stratosphere. It was like Father Christmas threatened not to come and 2022 was looking tough and then he arrived and delivered 8 Sues!!!!

In April 2022 Sue had work stack that read:

- 3 Priority tasks open
- 18 other tasks open
- **26 closed** over the last month
- 45 closed over the rest of the year (starting Oct 2021)
- 17 deliverables over the next 6 months

Sue has delivered new technology that includes detailed work into: Website, Payment systems, the College Connect Platform, WhatsApp Groups and technology.

Sue has delivered services beyond exceptions to ensure Reunion is going to run efficiently. She has managed and supported endless Old Boys event and I do not think there is an Old Boy



out there now who will not have met the efficiencies and services that Sue has brought to Old Boys.

Most pleasingly Sue has engaged with all Branch Chairs and is building this relationship very strongly and the increased number of Branch events, is evidence of this. (A core strategy and focus of Old Boys). The list of events above talks to this immense engagement Sue has achieved.

Kevin Smith is the Captain (at **Fullback** of course) but would be the first to admit the team has matured into a fine red wine this past year making leading it, easy. That said, credit is due and Kevin has engaged and it was clear that the securing of the sponsors of the new College Connect platform proved to be a team defining event lead by Kevin.

Kevin has also been instrumental in driving the new SuperSport contracting so that our main events are beamed around the globe.

Sally Upfold is the nippy **scrum half**, connecting us through media and of course marketing which has been critical in this our 125th Year. The new website has been a significant deliverable and with rich new content about to be secured from the 125th reunion, we know it will be put to good use.

Sam Paterson is the "new gal" who will need to occupy the **centre** channels to deliver the punchy communications we need using the correct technology and pitched at the right: level, frequency and agenda.

Mathew Marwick is the **Flyhalf /** 'General', marshalling play in some sadly dark days for College that has required firm control and good communications and wise shoulders.

Old Boys continue to be represented on Day Boy and Boarder Admissions and I am pleased to have Matthew to work with / through on this really important aspect of College.

Jenny Baptista is the elusive **Wing**. Its unlikely you will even "see" her but the technology and database expertise with critical technology thinking that she brings to the team, in the environment we do business in these days, are skills required if you want to score tries!

Our Patron / The Headmaster

I must report and thank our Patron and Headmaster, Mr. Luman who so generously hosts us Old Boys on Campus.



We have enjoyed consistent open dialog through the past year which I hope continues. I am struck by his tireless unrelating passion for our Old Boys. Often our meetings take place by call on a Sunday and most often take over an hour and he gives generously. When I am in Pietermaritzburg there is always time set aside to meet, often at his request and desire to engage with Old Boys.

He is more often the one driving the need for more Old Boys events and was the reason a Veteran's visit was hosted at College last year which included transport, put on by the school. He initiated a wonderful 125th Celebration event and hosted over 20 guests on the 22nd January 2022.

He has attended all our Cape events and even when I offer up contributions to accommodation, he turns this down always mindful of the need to "save old boys" a cash spend.

He offers his time generously and freely and when on a personal visit to see family in Melbourne in April 2022, he offered to meet with Old Boys and met with an OC. When he heads to the US in June/July, he has offered up time there and is even delaying his stop over in the UK by a night to run an event in London for Old Boys

- That OC, after 3 years of covid "isolation", find fulfillment and a sense of "my tribe"
 in.

It is my belief that we need to further increase the headcount in our Old Boys office to deliver into these objectives in order to ensure success. College Old Boys can't run on a "best endeavors basis" that it faces off to when paid resources are not hired and tasked to deliver on services.
